Death of Chas. Stone and widow Rachel admitted to tenancy. Richard and Eliz. Southam (Hore) and son James (Hore) Southam surrendered land to court and passed to Thomas Faulkener.

Dennis Willis died. Land surrendered.

Abel Skinner to repair lands.

Thomas Faulkener brought several indentures of lease.

Bridget Saunders brought indenture of lease

Indentures also from; Richard Allen, John Hutt, Robert Allen, William Gardener, Francis Brangwyn, Richard Hall.

Thomas Richards brought an indenture of lease dated twenty first of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Eight, whereby the said Willoughby, Earl of Abingdon demised unto Thomas Richards deceased a messuage or tenement and one yardland in Stroud in the Parish of Cumner called Whitleys and one toft and half yard land in Stroud called Rutters, a close called Woodb(r)each, one toft and half a yard land called Nokes's, one toft called Billocks and one piece of demesne land in the top field in Wytham. To hold unto the said Thomas Richards his executors, administrators and assigns from Lady day then last for the term of ninety nine years, if James Richards then aged about thirty two years, Thomas Richards then aged about twenty five years and Benjamin Richards then aged about twenty four years (sons of the said Thomas Richards) or either of them should so long live. Rent two pounds, three shillings and eight pence. All the lives in existence.
